# Self Determination Determination Program

## Who is eligible?

- Participants in the SDP must be an individual served by the regional center with an eligible diagnoses.
- Must live at home or in the community.
- Attend an approved orientation
- And agree to follow the rules of the program.

#### What is Self **Determination (SDP)?**

SELF

The Self-Determination Program (SDP) is a voluntary program that will help people with developmental disabilities and their families have them with an individual budget with which to implement their individual person-centered plans.

### **5** Principles of SDP:

- Freedom to exercise the same rights as all citizens; to establish, with freely chosen supports, family and friends, where they want to live, with whom they want to live, how their time will be occupied, and who supports
- Authority to control a budget in order to purchase services and supports of their choosing;
- **Support**, including the ability to arrange resources and personnel, which will allow flexibility to live in the community of their choice:
- **Responsibility**, which included the opportunity to take responsibility for making decisions in their own lives and accept a valued role in their community, and
- **Confirmation**, in making decisions in their own lives by designing and operating the services that they rely on.

#### How to get started:

- Attend a Mandatory Orientation:
  - Spanish, Interpretation for other languages is also available if requested at least five (5) business days prior to the session and at the time of RSVP.
- Attend an HRC local Self-Determination Advisory Committee meeting. The group meets on the 1st Wednesday of each month, from 6-8 PM, via Zoom.
